NewGenLib - Library Management System

NewGenLib is an integrated library management system developed by Verus Solutions Pvt Ltd. Domain expertise is provided by Kesavan Institute of Information and Knowledge Management in Hyderabad, India. NewGenLib version 1.0 was released in March 2005. On 9 January 2008, NewGenLib was declared Open Source Software under GNU GPL. The latest version of NewGenLib is 3.0.4 R1 released on 13 September 2012. Many libraries across the globe (mainly from the developing countries) are using NewGenLib as their Primary integrated library management system. In JMJ College for Women (Autonomous), Tenali uses this NewGenLib software for computerization of library books. A data base of book is maintained well, as we have got around 42,209 books in our library. The entire functioning is automated with "NewGenLib" software. Cataloguing, circulation of housekeeping (for stocking checking), serial control sections are computerized.

- Serials management

- Task to do today (daily scheduler)

With the help of this staff and students are able to check the no.of books available, by author and title, date and amount of purchase, easy to check reference books, general knowledge books, current affairs and job oriented course books etc..

National Library and Information Services Infrastructure for Scholarly Content (N-LIST)

The Project entitled "National Library and Information Services Infrastructure for Scholarly Content (N-LIST)", being jointly executed by the UGC-INFONET Digital Library Consortium, INFLIBNET Centre and the INDEST-AICTE Consortium, IIT Delhi provides for i) cross-subscription to e-resources subscribed by the two Consortia, i.e. subscription to INDEST-AICTE resources for universities and UGCINFONET resources for technical institutions; and ii) access to selected e-resources to colleges. The N-LIST project provides access to e-resources to students, researchers and faculty from colleges and other beneficiary institutions through server(s) installed at the INFLIBNET Centre. The authorized users from colleges can now access e-resources and download articles required by them directly from the publisher's website once they are duly authenticated as authorized users through servers deployed at the INFLIBNET Centre.

N-LIST: Four Components

The project has four distinct components

- I) To subscribe and provide access to selected UGC-INFONET e-resources to technical institutions (IITs, IISc, IISERs and NITs) and monitor its usage;
- II) To subscribe and provide access to selected INDEST e-resources to selected universities and monitor its usage;
- III) To subscribe and provide access to selected e-resources to 6,000 Govt./ Govt.-aided colleges and monitor its usage;
- IV) To act as a Monitoring Agency for colleges and evaluate, promote, impart training and monitor all activities involved in the process of providing effective and efficient access to e-resources to colleges.

This N-list Inflibnet was introduced in JMJ College for Women (Autonomous), Tenali in the year 2010 – 2011. All the students and staff have their own username and password to access the E-Resources available in the website http://nlist.inflibnet.ac.in to equip their knowledge. Our college renews every year by payment of Rs. 5000/. Students and staff are utilizing this facility to update their knowledge.

BAR CODE SYSTEM

A **barcode system** is a network of hardware and <u>software</u>, consisting primarily of <u>mobile</u> <u>computers</u>, <u>printers</u>, <u>handheld scanners</u>, infrastructure, and supporting software. Barcode systems are used to automate data collection, where hand recording is neither timely nor cost effective.

JMJ College uses BarTender 9.4.2781, LABEL AND RFID SOFTWARE, UltraLite Drivers by Seagull for barcoding system. It was installed on 30.08.2012. All the library books are assigned bar coding to make the retrieval of books easy for the readers. Due to this hand work for entering the data and searching time for a particular book is reduced.
