The activities planned by the Departments and Committees were carried out for the year 2020-21. The College had taken the initiative of obtaining accreditation under ISO 9001:2015 to signal its quality consciousness and quality commitment to the student community on 10th January, 2020. Our college was ranked 122<sup>nd</sup> in India and 19<sup>th</sup> in Andhra Pradesh among India's Best Private Autonomous Colleges, as per ranking announced by Education World India Autonomous Colleges Rankings 2020-21. The Academic Calendar for the new academic year was prepared by taking inputs from Governing Board, Academic Council Principal, Departments, Committees, Cells, Clubs and Examination Cell. Faculties and students undertook several MOOC Courses on Communicative English, Goods & Services Tax India (GST) Concepts of C-Programming, Life Skills, Python and Java Programming, Managing Online Classes and Co-Creating MOOCS:2.0 etc. offered by SWAYAM- NPTEL and ANU online platforms. IQAC organized one week Induction Programme for the First Year students. The staff members were trained to use Google Classroom by Dr.Ch.Tulasi, CCE, AGO on 16th October, 2020. MCQs, True or False and Match the following question banks and video lessons (LMS) for 20 minutes duration were prepared by staff members and uploaded in CCE Website. The staff and students were tested for COVID-19 from 5th to 14th December 2020. Conducted one day workshop on NAAC Criteria: Achieving Quality in Higher Education on 27th January 2021 by Rtd.Prof.M.Vincent Paul from Sir CR Reddy College, Eluru. Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) i.e. feedback on faculty was taken from all the students on 28th February 2021. IQAC conducted Student Induction Programme for all the I Degree students from 15th to 19th March 2021. Fact Finding Committee visited our college on 7th April, 2021. The College participated in the NIRF ranking 2021. The IQAC collected the data as per the NIRF Ranking Parameters and submitted the data. Annual data collection and submission to the online portal of All India Survey on Higher education (AISHE) for the academic year was successfully completed by IQAC and the data submitted was approved by AISHE. The AISHE ID for the institution is C-32812. IQAC initiated data collection and processing of data for the submission of Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for the year 2019-20. The AQAR was presented before the Academic Council for the approval and it was submitted online in the NAAC portal. All the activities and teaching learning process were converted to online mode due to COVID-19 pandemic.
