


## JMJ COLLEGE HISTORY AND HALL MARK OF EXCELLENCE

Jesus Mary Joseph (JMJ) College for Women, Tenali is one of the Minority institutions, established in 1963 by the Society of Jesus Mary Joseph (J.M.J.), an International Society that works for the poor and marginalized young women. JMJ College is one of the many educational institutions, established by the Society of Jesus Mary Joseph (J.M.J.) inspired by the teachings of Jesus Christ. Rev. Fr. Mathias Wolff S.J. founded the Society of the J.M.J. in the year 1822 in Netherlands, to meet the most felt need of the time ; i.e., education of the young girls, Spreading far and wide, the Society established its first branch in Indonesia in 1898 and India in 1904. The seven Dutch missionaries arrived in Guntur, Andhra Pradesh.

Rev. Sr. Stanislaus Swamikannu Pillai is the architect of J.M.J. apostolate of Education in India. She felt the need to provide higher education for girls especially economically backward and rural girls. This was met by establishing JMJ College for Women, Tenali. J.M.J. College is a Catholic Christian Minority Institution, registered under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860.

**The college was inaugurated on 1st July 1963**, with 75 students in PUC, Arts and Science in Degree. The University granted permission for **B.A. and B.Sc. Courses** from the academic year 1964-65. The college was admitted to grant-in-aid from 1965-66. The college was recognized by the U.G.C. in the year 1965. **Intermediate** was started from the year 1969. Permanent affiliation was accorded in 1971 by Andhra University. From 1976 the college was affiliated to Acharya Nagarjuna University. In the year 1982 General Inspection committee headed by Prof. D. Bhaskar Reddy, Vice Chancellor of Nagarjuna



University adjudged the college as one of **the best colleges** in the University. The college was conferred **Autonomous status** in 2005. The college was awarded "College with Potential for Excellence" in the year 2010 and completed successfully 50 golden years of its existence in 2013.



### VISION

#### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- ❖ The day begins with a common prayer at 9.25 A.M in which all should participate with respect and attention.
- ❖ Students must be regular and punctual in coming to the college
- ❖ Every student must get 80% attendance to appear for the Semester Examination in each Semester
- ❖ Students must maintain a sense of decorum and discipline in the college and outside
- ❖ Ragging is totally prohibited in the college and it leads to dismissal from the college
- ❖ Students should wear College Uniform and ID cards as long as they are inside the college campus.
